Guided by excellence, innovation, and inclusivity, the academic year 2024–25 has been a remarkable chapter in the journey of Army Public School, Dhaula Kuan. The school has reaffirmed its position as a leading institution in the country by achieving excellence across academics, co-curricular pursuits, technological advancement, and social responsibility.

In a world shaped by rapid transformation, APSDK remains steadfast in its vision of nurturing empowered learners—resilient, responsible, and ready to shape the future. The report outlines the school community's key achievements and goals during the year.

1. National Recognition and Rankings

In a testament to its academic excellence and institutional distinction, Army Public School, Dhaula Kuan has been ranked 12th nationally in the Indian Institutional Ranking Framework (IIRF) 2025. This marks a remarkable leap from its 24th position in 2023–24, underscoring the school's unwavering pursuit of educational innovation, holistic development, and performance-driven growth. Significantly, it is the only Army Public School to feature within the top 15 schools nationally.

Further reinforcing its national stature, the EducationWorld India School Rankings 2023–24 placed the school 2nd in Delhi NCR and 3rd across India in its category.

Further, in the India's Best Schools 2024 survey conducted by Careers360, the school earned an Exemplary Rating for its excellence in curriculum delivery, infrastructure, inclusivity, and student outcomes.

2. Academic Excellence 2024–25

Academic excellence continued to be a defining priority during the academic year 2024–25. Army Public School Dhaula Kuan achieved outstanding results in the CBSE Board Examinations, securing the Academic Performance Index (API) of 542 (Class XII).

The school also attained **first position in the Western Command** in the Very Large Category for Class XII, reflecting consistent scholastic achievement and institutional commitment to high academic standards.

Scholastic Achievements and Recognition

Exceptional individual performances marked the academic year, with students of class XII (24-25 Batch) achieving remarkable scores across streams:

- Saumya Singh (Science) – 98.4%
- Tanya Goyat (Commerce) – 95.8%
- Manya Singh (Humanities) – 97.8%

Further indicators of academic leadership include:

- The school achieved the **highest Academic Performance Index (API)** among the three Army Public Schools located in Delhi.
- It secured the **first position** in both the Very Large and Large Category schools within the **Western Command**.

Class X students of Army Public School Dhaula Kuan delivered an outstanding academic performance in the CBSE Board Examinations for the academic year 2024–25, achieving a **100% pass percentage**.

Top individual scores reflect the consistent academic rigor maintained by the school:

- Ayush Kumar – 97.2%
- Abhishek Sharma – 97%
- Aadya Parashar – 96.6%

The school also takes immense pride in the **achievements of its Children with Special Needs (CwSN)**. All seven students in this category scored above 66%, with the highest reaching 83.4%, reflecting the school's inclusive academic environment.

Further establishing its position as a centre of academic excellence, the school secured **the 3rd position** in the **Western Command** among Very Large Category Schools.

3. Placements and Career Pathways

Army Public School Dhaula Kuan continued its tradition of academic excellence and career readiness, as reflected in the higher education placements of the 2023–24 batch:

- A total of 35 students secured admission to reputed engineering colleges across the country.
- 13 students gained entry into leading medical institutions, embarking on careers in healthcare and research.
- 11 students were admitted to top law colleges, marking their formal entry into the legal profession.
- 4 students joined prominent management institutes, initiating their journey in the business and corporate sectors.
- 15 students were accepted into prestigious colleges under the University of Delhi, upholding a legacy of academic distinction.
- 13 students joined the Defence Services, honouring the school's longstanding commitment to service and patriotism.

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- 1 student secured admission to the University of Manchester, marking the school's growing global academic footprint.

4. Fostering Innovation: Atal Tinkering Lab Achievements

The Atal Tinkering Lab (ATL) at Army Public School Dhaula Kuan continued to function as a dynamic hub of creativity, innovation, and technological advancement during the academic year 2024–25. Students demonstrated remarkable achievements on national platforms, further strengthening the school's reputation for fostering scientific temperament and entrepreneurial thinking.

- In a landmark accomplishment, Army Public School Dhaula Kuan was awarded a record-breaking **cash prize of ₹10 lakh** at the **National Level 3DPCOE Hackathon**—the highest ever received by the institution and the largest among all Army Public Schools to date.
- Students secured a place in the **Top 10** of the **Tinkerpreneur Competition**, attaining a commendable 4th position for demonstrating excellence in coding and design thinking.
- At the **9th Skill Championship 2025** held at IIT Delhi, the school secured **second position**, along with a cash prize of ₹10,000, in recognition of the students' technical acumen and problem-solving abilities.

Entrepreneurial initiatives also received notable recognition. Gurakshat and Nic, of class XII, were declared **champions** at the **National Entrepreneur Drive – Teen Tycoons** hosted by BITS Pilani. The duo won the first prize and a **cash award of ₹12,000**. Their innovative business ideas attracted internship and job offers, highlighting the practical impact of student-led innovation.

Further accomplishments included:

- Qualification in the regional round and participation in the **National Youth Robotics Challenge**
- Completion of an 8-week **certification course in Data Science and Artificial Intelligence** by **17 students** through **IIT Madras**, providing exposure to emerging technologies and enhancing future readiness

5. Vocational Education and Student Enterprise

Army Public School Dhaula Kuan remains committed to developing employability and life skills through vocational and skill-based education, in alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. This commitment has materialised into meaningful student-led initiatives and real-world experiential learning.

A key highlight of the year was the successful **launch of student-led startup**, exhibited during the **Udhyastra Exhibition** held on the front lawns of Raina House. These ventures reflected entrepreneurial initiative, creativity, and leadership qualities cultivated within the school environment.

The dedicated vocational education lab continued to offer hands-on training in a variety of skill-based disciplines, including:

- Tote bag designing
- Tie-dye techniques

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- Jewellery making
- Fabric folder crafting
- Soap and candle making
- Baking and culinary skills

The school's holistic development approach also yielded notable outcomes in inclusive sports participation:

- Aaryan Aaditya secured a **Gold Medal** at the State-Level Basketball Championship
- Sushant achieved a **Silver Medal** in the same event and also earned a **Silver Medal** in Football at the Special Olympics

6. Achievements of CWSN Athletes

Inclusion at Army Public School Dhaula Kuan is embedded not merely as a policy but as a core practice anchored in empathy, empowerment, and equity. The institution's sustained commitment to supporting Children With Special Needs (CWSN) extends well beyond academics, encompassing co-curricular engagement, life skills training, and sporting excellence.

During the academic year 2024–25, CWSN athletes delivered commendable performances in various athletic competitions, exemplifying resilience, discipline, and competitive spirit. Their efforts culminated in a total of **22 medals**, comprising:

- 15 Gold Medals
- 6 Silver Medals
- 1 Bronze Medal

7. Community Engagement and Infrastructure Advancement

As part of the **Vidhyanjali Project**, Army Public School Dhaula Kuan **adopted Sri Gurunanak Senior Secondary Girls School**, extending academic support and institutional expertise to strengthen educational quality. In recognition of its exemplary role as a Mentor School, the institution was honoured by State authorities. Continued engagement with Vidhyanjali initiatives also led to the conferral of the **Platinum Badge** by the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education.

The academic session 2024–25 witnessed major infrastructural enhancements aimed at creating a more inclusive, technology-driven, and future-ready learning environment. Key developments included:

- Installation of new classroom furniture to improve student comfort
- Integration of interactive digital panels to facilitate technology-enabled learning
- Upgradation of computer labs with the latest configuration systems
- Renovation of the admission area for enhanced visitor experience
- Addition of Porta Cabins to optimise space utilisation within the campus

A significant milestone was marked with the inauguration of Balvatika on 27th February 2025, thereby expanding the school's academic offerings to include foundational learning. This aligns the institution with the NEP 2020 vision of K–12 education.

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8. Co-Curricular and Sports Achievements 2024–25

In 2024–25, students of Army Public School Dhaula Kuan excelled in diverse co-curricular and sporting arenas, earning recognition at state and national levels.

Arts and Literary Achievements:

Akshita and Namita represented Delhi State at the **national-level Kala Utsav**, while two students secured **second and third positions** in a national painting competition.

In literature, **Shivansh, Vanisha, and Sudhhant** were nationally recognised in the **Creative Writing Competition**. The school earned **first position** in **Traditional Storytelling Dance** at the State-Level *Kala Utsav*, and Aditya Shourya won the State Poem Recitation Competition.

Academic Competitions:

The school secured second position in the **National Inter-School Quiz Competition** (₹15,000 cash prize).

In the **National Mathematics Olympiad**, Ayush (IX–X category) secured second place with a cash prize of ₹6,000, Barun placed third with ₹4,000, and Vishu Chowdhary (XI–XII category) was declared national champion, receiving a cash award of ₹10,000.

Science and Innovation:

Happy (Class IX) received the *INSPIRE MANAK Award* with a ₹10,000 cash prize for a nationally selected innovation.

Inter-APS Achievements:

- Winners: Command Quiz
- Runners-up: Command Ethics Bowl
- Second position: Cluster-Level Zonal Debate

Sports Achievements:

The school introduced Archery, Golf, and Horse Riding to diversify its sports curriculum. APSDK teams secured second position in U-15 and U-13 Boys' and U-15 Girls' categories at the Delhi State Archery Championship.

Golfers Yogya, Aryan, Aadyot, and Aarohi performed strongly at state and national levels. In squash, Gurveer won the *Northern Slam*, while Shreshth and Aarohi attained top national rankings. Aarohi also excelled in golf and baseball.

In shooting, Agrima Kanwar secured fifth position in the Junior Category at the National Championship and has been selected to represent India internationally in May 2025.

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Team Sports Achievements

Army Public School Dhaula Kuan continued its strong performance in team sports during the academic year 2024–25, securing top positions across multiple disciplines at various competitive levels.

- At the **State Level**, the school teams emerged **victorious in the Under-17 and Under-19 categories for Football, Basketball, and Hockey**.
- In **athletics**, the **relay team** secured **third position** in the **Delhi State School Games**.
- At the **Zonal Level**, the school maintained a consistent winning streak across both **boys' and girls' categories in Hockey, Badminton, Volleyball, Basketball, Football, and Lawn Tennis**.

In recognition of outstanding all-round performance in sports, **Army Public School Dhaula Kuan** was conferred with both the **Overall Girls Championship Trophy** and the **Overall Boys Championship Trophy** by the **Directorate of Education, Zone 20**.

9. Recognitions and Faculty Achievements

In the academic year 2024–25, four students of Army Public School Dhaula Kuan were conferred with the **AWWA Award of Excellence and Appreciation** for their outstanding academic achievements, discipline, and all-round development. These accolades reflect the school's continued commitment to fostering excellence within a nurturing and supportive environment.

Faculty members also earned prestigious honours for their significant contributions to the field of education. **Mrs. Meetu Rathore, Principal**, Army Public School Dhaula Kuan, was **awarded the Woman Icon Award 2025** at the International Women Summit, for her leadership in inclusive education and building future-ready institutions.

Ms. Anupama Mahajan, PGT Mathematics and Exam Cell Incharge, was **conferred the Chief of Army Staff (COAS) Commendation Card**—a rare and prestigious honour awarded for exceptional commitment to academic service, integrity, and values-driven mentoring.

Additionally, three faculty members were recognised with the **AWWA Award of Excellence and Appreciation**, acknowledging their innovative pedagogical approaches, dedication to student growth, and contribution to school enrichment initiatives.
