Annual Report (Academic Year 2022-2023)

Introduction

Army Public School Dhaula Kuan, for the academic year 2022-2023, continued its commitment to academic excellence and holistic development of its students. This report provides an overview of the school's current student and teacher strength, key activities and initiatives, community service efforts, inclusion programs, resource rooms, significant achievements in academics and co-curricular activities, and college admissions of students.

Current Student & Teacher Strength

- Primary Wing (1-5): The school's primary wing, consisting of students from grades 1 to 5, has an optimum capacity of 1455, with 1424 students currently enrolled.
- Middle Wing (6-10): The middle wing, comprising of grades 6 to 10, currently has 2253 students in attendance.
- Senior Wing (11-12): The senior wing, consisting of grades 11 and 12, has 942 students presently enrolled.
- Teacher Strength: The school has a dedicated teaching staff with 59 Primary Teachers (PRTs), 90 Trained Graduate Teachers (TGTs), and 33 Post Graduate Teachers (PGTs).

Inclusion

The school is committed to inclusive education, with a total of 55 students with special needs, including hearing impairment, intellectual disability, specific learning disability, autism, loco motor issues, cerebral palsy, thalassemia, ADHD, mental illness, chronic neurological conditions, and multiple disabilities.

Resource Room

The school provides a resource room for special children, hosting competitions and vocational labs.

Visits

Distinguished guests, including the AG Lt. Gen CB Ponnappa, GOC Delhi Area, the Last COS Delhi Area, and the Regional President AWWA, visited the school.

Student Workshops

Students actively participated in workshops and undertook various projects during the academic year.

Academic Achievements

- In Class XII, the school achieved an API of more than 500, ranking among the top 20 schools in the country and receiving a Rs. 30,000 award from AWES, WC.
- In Class X, the school received Rs. 75,000 from AWES for achieving the second-highest API (All India) in the very large category schools.
- Several students excelled in various national-level exams, including NTSE.

English Essay Writing Competition (CBSE Zonals): A 1st prize was awarded for exceptional essay writing.

CBSE Zonals Drama Competition: The school secured the 3rd prize in the CBSE Zonals Drama Competition.

CBSE Zonals Swar (Instrumental Music) Competition: A 1st prize was achieved in the instrumental music competition.

CBSE Zonals Percussion (Tabla) Competition: The school secured the 3rd prize in the tabla competition.

CBSE Zonals Vocal Music Competition: The school achieved the 2nd prize in the vocal music competition.

Sports Achievements:

Athletics (Zonals): The school secured an impressive tally of 16 gold, 9 silver, and 11 bronze medals in athletics at the zonal level.

Basketball (Zonals): The school excelled in basketball, securing 1st position in the Senior Boys, Junior Boys, and Sub-Junior Boys categories. For girls, they achieved 2nd position for Junior and Sub-Junior and 3rd position for Senior.
