Dear Parents,

Summer is the perfect time for children to explore, discover, and learn through fun. Here is a set of engaging, hands-on activities designed for your child. We encourage you to assist them in completing these tasks and making learning joyful.



Art & Craft

- Fruit Printing Fun – Use cut fruits (apple, ladyfinger, etc.) to do printing on paper.
- My Summer Collage – Create a collage using old magazines or pictures of summer items (ice cream, sun, beach, fruits).

Literacy Activities

- Story Time with Parents – Listen to 5 short stories and draw your favorite scene from each.
- Alphabet Treasure Hunt – Find things around the house starting with each letter A to Z (or A to L).
- Name Tracing – Practice writing their name with crayons, in sand, or with finger paints.

- Number Hopscotch – Draw a hopscotch grid and jump on numbers while counting aloud.

Nature & Life Skills

- Water the Plants – Help water plants daily and observe changes.
- Fruit Salad Making – With help, cut and mix fruits. Learn names, colors, and taste.
- Cloth Folding Challenge – Practice folding napkins, handkerchiefs or small towels.

Creative Expression

- Dance to a Rhyming Song – Record a short dance to a favorite rhyme or song.
- Role Play – Dress up like a community helper (doctor, teacher, etc.) and act for 2 minutes.

- - Share 2-3 pictures of the child doing any activity with short captions.





Color the shapes correctly.







