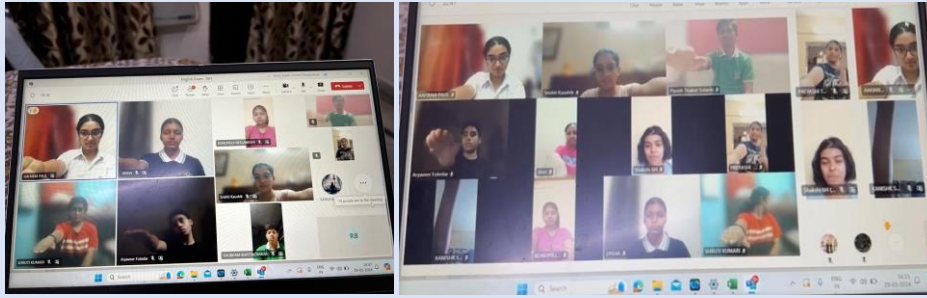


21 May to 24 May 2024: Mental Health Online Workshop for Parents

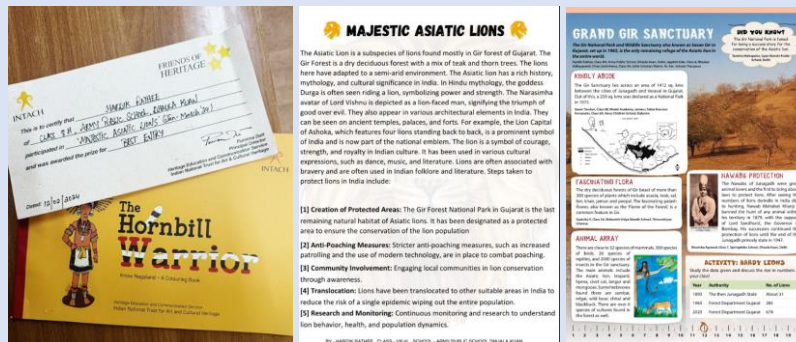


An online **'No Tobacco "pledge for classes 10-12"'** was organized to create awareness about ill effects of Tobacco. This was a mandate by DOE.

13 April 2024 - ANNUAL DAY

25 April 2024: Talent Hunt Classes 9 and 10 (Vocals and Instrumental)

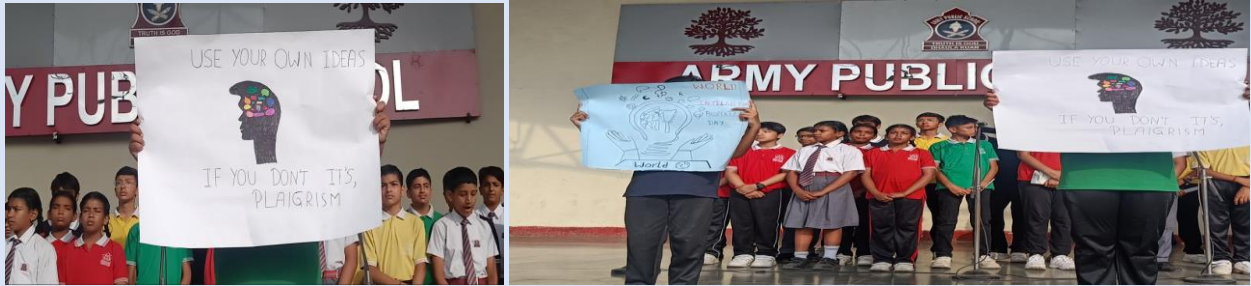


The Talent Hunt Competition for vocals and instrumental was organized for the students of Classes 9 and 10.
