This year, the theme of World Environment Day is "Reimagine. Recreate. Restore.". According to the WED website, every three seconds, the world loses enough forest to cover a football pitch, and over the last century, humans have destroyed half of the wetlands. The theme means to prevent, halt and reverse this damage – to go from exploiting nature to healing it. This World Environment Day will kick off the global mission to revive these billions of hectares. 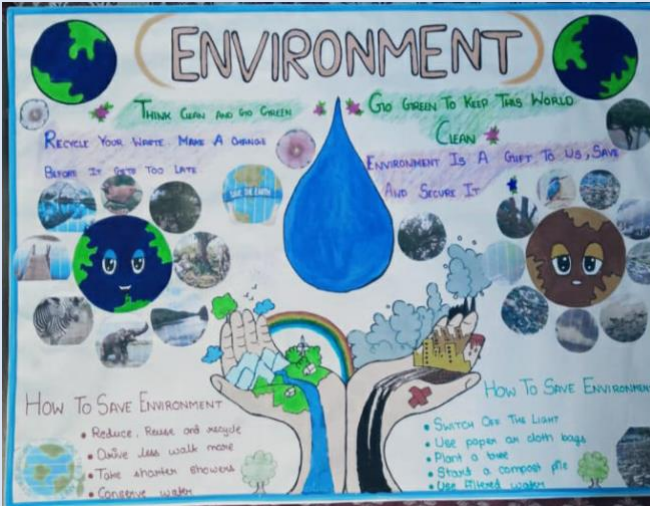

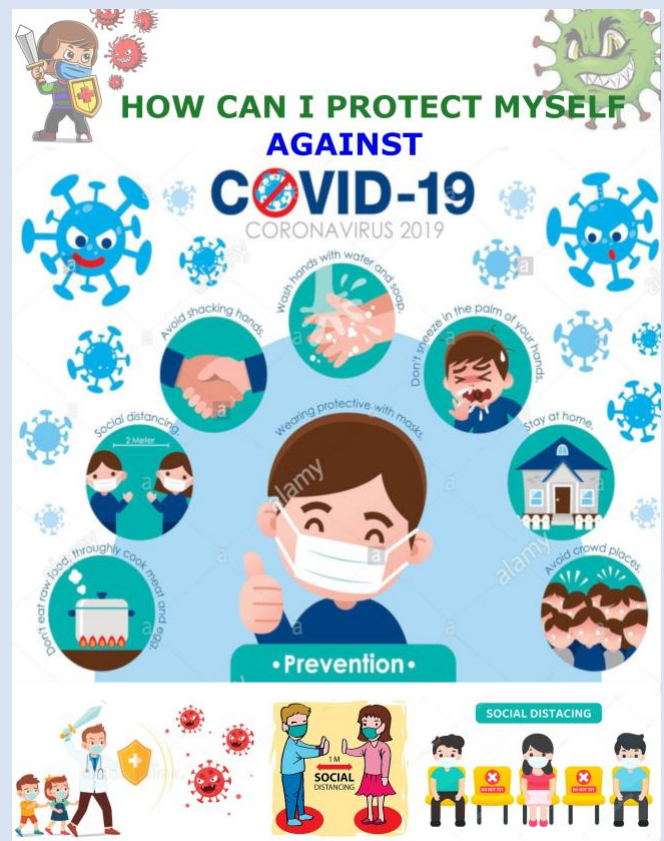

Students of class 9-10 contributed by hosting a **special assembly in the honour of the Kargil Martyrs**.

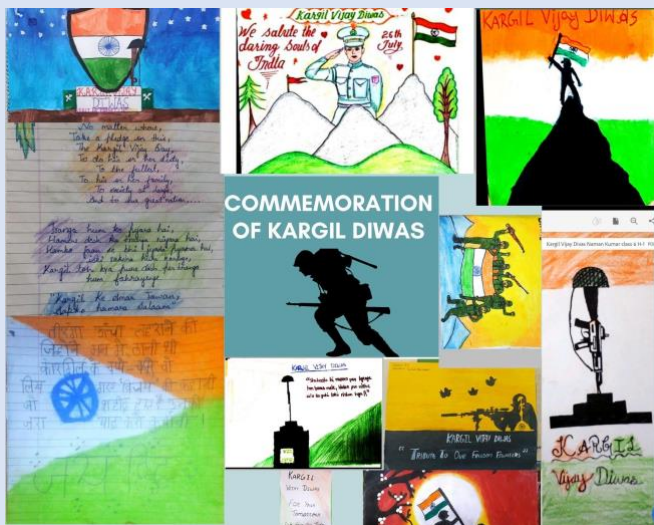
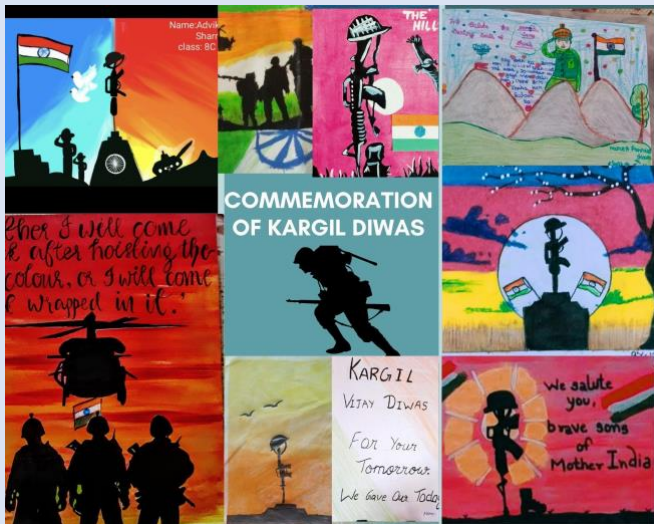
