- f. Grey or woollen socks, without any design, calf length.
- g. School Tie & Belt
- h. Hair Band / Ribbon: Black

SPORTS UNIFORM

- 1. Girls: (all classes) : Black lowers and T-shirt of the respective house colour.
- 2. **Boys:** (a) Classes I to VII : Black shorts/lowers and T-shirt.of the respective house colour.

(b) Classes VIII to XII : Black Lower and T-shirt. of the respective house colour.

- 3. Socks: White with stripes of respective house colour.
- 4. **Shoes:** White Gola/CanvasShoes
- 5. Sports Practice Uniform : Black track, lowers



IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

Parents to read all the instructions carefully for compliance:

- 1. Parents to acknowledge and sign all the undertakings in the discipline pages of the almanac. Any query on academics and discipline matters will be dealt with by the class teacher concerned.
- 2. Adhere strictly to the days and timings fixed for visiting school to meet the Vice Principal /Principal.
- 3. Parents must attend all the Parent Teacher Meetings.
- 4. Parents must collect and monitor their ward's progress report in person. The progress report will not be given to the students/relatives.
- 5. Inform the school office in a mail /written application in writing of any change in residential address/telephone number /rank of parent/s etc. So that parents may be contacted immediately, if necessary.
- 6. Parents must not enter the classroom to meet their ward or the teacher during teaching hours. They can meet the teachers only on PTM days or after school hours with prior appointment.
- 7. Parents must take immediate action on the letters/ SMS/ whatsapp messages sent from the school from time to time.
- 8. Daily pocket money should be restricted. Excessive spending should be discouraged. Birthday celebration of the child should be confined to his/her classmates only and that too to a modest scale(such as distribution of toffees to each friend) to make it a uniform affair within the school premises. Child should come in school uniform on birthday. School is not responsible for loss of any expensive item carried by the child.
- 9. For any specific medical problem, the parents must inform the school authority prior to the session. Medical documents to be submitted to the class teacher & at the school office.
- 10. Attention is drawn to the fact that the criticism of a teacher or the school in the presence of a child, causes the child to lose respect for the teacher or school and retards wholesome progress.
- 11. While seeking leave, send a leave application before proceeding for the same.
- 12. Check and sign the school diary every day.
- 13. Check the homework of your ward daily and ensure that the notebooks are complete in all respects and are checked by the teachers on a regular basis.



- 14. Fill in the movement in the outpass register in case the child is to be taken early due to medical reasons only.
- 15. Ensure the safety of the child at home, in and around the neighbourhood and counsel him/her about personal safety on a regular basis.
- 16. Give a contact number or the number of the person to be contacted in case of any emergency.
- 17. Please ensure your ward carries a water bottle (minimum 1 litre) daily to school.
- 18. No half day leave will be given to attend any family function.
- 19. Parents are not allowed to go to the classes directly.
- 20. Parents who make independent transport arrangements for their wards by hiring vans will be fully responsible for the safety of their wards. They must ensure that proper verification of drivers is done and all safety measures are taken to avoid any untoward incident.
- 21. The class teacher must be informed about the medical history of the ward to ensure proper medical attention in the event of an emergency. If the child falls sick in school or is injured, he /she will be taken to the school MI Room / Base Hospital immediately. Parents will be informed, and must come and pick up the child.
- 22. Routine letters /Notices /Circulars will be uploaded on the school website, MS Teams and will also be sent through students. Parents are expected to check them regularly and acknowledge such letters.
- 23. For any query regarding academics or discipline, the Class Teacher or Tutorial Head concerned must be contacted first. Please do not approach the Principal/ Manager/Chairman directly.
- 24. Half day leaves are not permitted. In case the child has an appointment with a doctor kindly arrange it after school hours. If a child is unwell, kindly refrain from sending them to school.

Parents must ensure that their ward:

- 1. Comes to school on time. If they report late for the 3rd time in a month the child will not be allowed to attend the classes and will be sent back home.
- 2. Comes in neat and clean uniform with shoes polished and nails trimmed. The child must have a proper haircut.
- 3. Brings nutritious food and fruit daily in tiffin.
- 4. Brings water bottle, handkerchief and hand sanitizer.
- 5. Is not be sent to school, when he/she is suffering from communicable diseases like conjunctivitis, dermatitis etc. This is for strict compliance. A medical certificate for the same should be submitted to the class teacher.



6. Should not carry money for any activity conducted in the school unless a diary note duly signed by the class teacher is received.

RESTRICTED

Students are not allowed to:

- 1. Bring junk food e.g. maggi, noodles, burger etc.
- 2. Wear rings/wrist bands/bangles/danglers/ Heavy Kadas etc. or bring any valuable item. In case found wearing, it will be confiscated.
- 3. Apply henna/nail polish on hands, wear kajal or colour their hair.
- 4. Bring mobile phones, pen drives, card readers, electrical gadgets or any other objectionable material. The above will be confiscated and will not be returned.
- 5. Smoke or use any kind of drug.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- 1. Students must purchase white action shoes instead of canvas shoes.
- 2. PTM will be conducted after every exam.
- 3. Parents applying for TC of their ward before 10th of the month, will be charged Annual charges and fee up to the previous month.
- 4. Parents applying for TC of their ward after 10th of the month, will be charged Annual charges and fee for that month also.
- 5. Students attending provisional classes will have to pay the fee for the first quarter.
- 6. Parents of class X students should apply for TC before the board result if their ward will not continue in the same school, otherwise the parent has to pay the fee for the period.

SCHOOL RULES AND DISCIPLINE

The ultimate achievement of education is a disciplined mind which works within the constraints and challenges of life and follows an act of rules without impinging upon the rights of others. Alternatively, a disciplined environment has a good impact on the development of growing minds and offers a better grooming space.

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1. Students must be regular in class and in various school activities.
- 2. No half day leave is permitted.
- 3. If ill, a medical certificate is a must along with a leave application.
- 4. Personal hygiene must be maintained
- 5. Be courteous to all & obey your elders.
- 6. Instructions from the portfolio holders must be followed.



- 7. Students of APS should observe polite standards wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
- 8. They should greet their teachers with 'Jai Hind' when they meet them.
- 9. It is mandatory for all students to bring the Almanac to school everyday.
- 10. The student should affix his/her photograph and fill the required information, duly signed by the parents, in the space provided in the almanac.
- 11. Students must wear their school ID cards during school hours.
- 12. Special care must be taken of all school property.
- 13. (Do not litter. Make proper use of garbage bins. Do not scratch or spoil the school furniture. Do not write or draw anything on the walls/ belongings of others.)
- 14. Students must move in an orderly manner while they move from one place to another within the school premises.
- 15. Students are allowed to use the school canteen only during the break time.

The following are the acts and misconduct which amount to forbidden practices

- 1. Absence from classes without the permission of the teacher/ Vice-Principal/ Principal.
- 2. Misbehaviour towards teachers or any other employee of the school.
- 3. Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher
- 4. Intentional disturbance of classes.
- 5. Bullying/Rowdyism and rude behaviour.
- 6. Eve-teasing/misbehaviour towards girl-students.
- 7. Bringing unauthorised people/articles inside the school.
- 8. Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.
- 9. Any behaviour unbecoming of a student.
- 10. Smoking/Chewing gutkha/Paan/Khaini etc.
- 11. Use of drugs or intoxicants (except on prescription by a registered Medical Practitioner)
- 12. Any form of gambling.
- 13. Theft/pilferage of school/student's property
- 14. Disfiguring or otherwise damaging any school property.
- 15. Use of violence in any form.
- 16. Casteism, communalism or practice of untouchability.



- 17. Propagating a strike/ disruption of classes
- 18. Association with banned organisations.
- 19. Students are not permitted to buy eatables from vendors outside the school premises.
- 20. No student is allowed to come to school in a self-driven vehicle.
- 21. Bullying and use of foul language is prohibited and punishable as per school rules.
- 22. School has a zero tolerance policy for any form of physical abuse.

DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE

Discipline committee for the students will be constituted every year in the beginning of the session by the Principal for classes I- V, VI-VIII, IX- X, XI & XIII. Counsellor will be a member of all the committees. Composition will be PO- HM/ Members will be TH, Discipline In-charge, Class Teachers of affected students.

Parents are required to cooperate with the school in developing their children into progressive, balanced, morally strong and effective youths, by helping them to observe the general code of conduct in and outside the school. This process is set out with distinct stages which, in normal circumstances, are followed sequentially.

FORMAL DISCIPLINARY PROCESS

DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

- Any student breaching the school rules & regulations like absenting him/ herself for more than 6 days without approval or found indulging in forbidden practices will make the student liable for action. Discipline policy is based on an objective "Card system" with coloured cards handed out for each instance of disciplinary breach by a student.
- **Blue Card:** will be issued for breach of discipline considered minor by the class teacher & Vice Principal, Signature of the parent shall be obtained on the card. The card will be filed by the TH.. Three such cards will make the student liable for suspension for three calendar days. In case the child has been issued three Blue Cards, for the next offence, even if it is minor, the child will be issued a Yellow card.
- Yellow Card: This will be issued where breach is considered to be significant but not serious. It will be brought to the notice of the Vice Principal. Signature of the parent shall be obtained on the card The card will be filed by the TH. Two such cards will make the student liable for suspension for seven calendar days.



In case the child has been issued three Yellow Cards, for the next offence even, if it is minor, the child will be issued a Red card and the parent has to withdraw the child in the next academic session. The record of Red cards will maintained by the Vice Principal

• **Red Card:** this will be issued in case where a student breaches discipline which is considered major by the discipline committee . Action, as per the recommendation of the discipline committee will be taken. Till then students will be suspended.

COUNSELLING SERVICE

The school has full time counsellors and special educators to help students and parents. They are available on all working days for individual sessions to help with both academic and emotional / behavioural difficulties faced by students of all age groups.

WITHDRAWAL FROM THE SCHOOL

The Principal may recommend withdrawal of a student from the school

- i. If the student's behaviour or influence on others in the opinion of the Principal, be found detrimental to the general discipline or interest of the school.
- ii. If a student fails in a class for two successive years or fails twice in three years.

STRIKING THE NAME OFF THE ROLLS

The name of the student may be struck off the rolls by the Principal on account of non-payment of fees and other dues, 20 days after the last day for payment. Parents will be given a reasonable opportunity to show cause against the proposed action.



BULLYING AND RAGGING RESPONSIBILITIES OF STUDENTS, PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

No student who witnesses ragging or bullying may stand by or participate, but must notify an adult at school and an adult at home as quickly as possible. Any parent or guardian who witnesses or is notified of ragging has an obligation to apprise the Principal as quickly as possible. Anonymous reports will be accepted but no disciplinary action will be taken on the sole basis of an anonymous report.

RESPONIBSILITY OF SCHOOL & CLASS TEACHERS

Anti-Bullying Day will be celebrated on second Wednesday of October every year to create awareness School counsellor to conduct sessions of anti bullying for all wings periodically, class teacher must read out the main points of bullying and ragging specified in the SOP to the children during the zero period atleast once every week. The Hierarchy to be followed in reporting of bullying cases is CT->TH-> Vice Principal

DIGITAL / CYBER LAWS

- 1. Students must not eat/drink near the IT devices
- 2. Must respect a school equipment and should not indulge in moving the IT equipment and/ or cables.
- 3. Students must not cause damage to any equipment, if they spot any damage, they must inform the teachers immediately.
- 4. Must not use flash drives or any other external media (Cell phone, hard disk, CD, camera etc.) for the purpose of

a) Saving or transferring the work.

b) Installing new software without due permission from the computer faculty.

- 5. Viewing social media sites / registering on any website / downloading any material for use mut be under the strict supervision of the teacher.
- In the computer lab, Internet access is allowed only after permission from computer faculty and the computer faculty reserves the right to check the IDs of the users.
- 7. Students are not allowed to bring equipment such as iPad, iPod, PSP, mobiles phones etc. to the school. Any such equipment confiscated from the students will be kept by the school.
- 8. Students must report incidents of Cyber Bullying and misuse of IT resources to their teachers/ parents immediately.
- 9. Hacking emails of school staff or others.



WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT BREACHES THE SCHOOL'S CYBER POLICY

- 1. If you breach this policy, you will be subjected to Army Public School Behaviour Mangament Policy. Minor breaches (like installing new software, accessing internet, connecting IT devices without prior permission of the teacher concerned etc.) of this policy will result in a suspension period of two weeks.
- 2. Major breaches (like cyber bullying, identity theft etc.) of this policy will result in the suspension period of upto ten weeks.
- 3. If you behave online in a manner that threatens the well-being of another child, student, parent or member of the school community, even if this occurs off-site during or after the school hours, the Principal/VP/HM has the authority to take appropriate action.
- 4. When it is suspected that a personal electronic device such as a mobile phone is used to capture images of a crime (such as an assault), or contains any other evidence of a crime, the device will be confiscated and handed to the police.
- 5. If the Principal suspects an electronic crime has been committed, this will be reported to the Police Department. Where there is a further reasonable suspicion that evidence of a crime, such as an assault, is contained on a mobile phone or other electronic device such as notebook, computer etc., and the device will be confiscated and handed to the investigating police officer. The police will determine any further action.
- 6. These actions may be taken even if the alleged incident occurs off site and / or out of school hours.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS :

- 1. Place the computer in an open area in your home not in your children's bedroom.
- 2. Set clear expectations for your children, based on age and maturity.
- 3. Install parental control (content filtering) software.
- 4. Learn internet basics, be approachable and lead by example.

TIPS FOR PARENTS TO AVOID AND IDENTIFY CYBER BULLYING

- 1. Discuss any changes in mood or behaviour with them. If you observe any concern, help your child to stay connected to friends and family friends and family they trust.
- 2. Talk to your child about cyber bullying before it happens.
- 3. Be aware of what your child is doing online, and explore it with them.
- 4. Keep the lines of communication open so your child will be comfortable talking



about it if something is worrying them. Help your child to develop the skills they need to interact safely and respectfully online. Guide their online activities and help them learn to communicate appropriately with friends and family.

5. Help your child to block anyone who sends offensive content. Most social networking services allow users to block and report someone who is behaving badly. "Cyber bullying won't stop if it is ignored – you can help by listening to your child and working with them to have control of the situation."

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS & PARENTS TO USE THE INTERNET SAFELY :

- 1. Don't give out personal information such as your address or phone number.
- 2. Do not share passwords, user names, account IDs or PINs with anyone besides your parents.
- 3. Do not share other people's personal information or say things that might violate the safety or rights of others, even if you mean it as a 'joke'.
- 4. Do not leave the IC devices unattended.
- 5. Don't become online 'friends' with people you don't know.
- 6. Don't open emails or attachments from people you don't know.
- 7. Never arrange to meet someone in person whom you have met online.
- 8. If anything you see or read online worries you, tell your parents/teachers about it.
- 9. Never give out personal details in messenger or in personal profiles.
- 10. Remember that people may not be who they say they are.
- 11. Don't send pictures to strangers.
- 12. Most reputable chat rooms allow you to block messages from a particular sender.
- 13. Be careful about whom you share photos with.
- 14. Use social network privacy settings so only your friends can see your stuff.
- 15. What you do not do in real life, don't do on the internet. This includes all kinds of cyber bullying using text, photos and videos.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMME AND COURSES

The medium of instruction is English, with Hindi as a compulsory language till class X. The course of studies up to class X provides for a general all-round education and examines the students in English, Hindi, Mathematics, Science, (Physics, Chemistry and Biology), Social Studies (Civics, Economics, History and Geography) and Sixth Skill Subject Artificial Intelligence/ Information Technology or Physical Activity Trainer. Grading system is used to assess, Art Education, Health and Physical Education, Work Education and Discipline.

SUBJECTS FOR CLASS XI AND XII

These subjects are offered under three major streams-Science, Commerce and Humanities as follows.

- 1. Language English.
- 2. Science Elective Subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics.
- 3. Commerce Elective Subjects Accounts, Business Studies, Economics.
- 4. Mathematics.
- 5. Humanities Elective Subjects History, Political Science, Geography.
- 6. Psychology, Home Science, Elective, NCC, Computer Science, Economics.
- 7. Painting, PAT.
- 1. The CBSE policy on Maths and Basic Maths shall also be taken into account while allocating streams.
- 2. In case of transfer after completion of XI for admission to class XII, no change of subject/stream will be permitted as per CBSE Examination Bye Laws. This would also be applicable for promotion to Class XII in the same school.
- 3. For giving the same stream on transfer certificate, proof of posting of the parent/allotment of separated family accommodation/permission for hired married accommodation by the station HQ would be required.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

Unfair means :

In case any candidate adopts unfair means and caught red handed by invigilator, a new sheet will be provided after confiscating the previous one with the countersign of the invigilator. Parents will be called to take the child back home.



Assessment /Evaluation will be conducted as per CBSE guidelines.

Attendance:

A regular course of study as per CBSE Bye Laws requires at least 75% attendance in the classes held. Child will not be allowed to sit for the annual examination if the 75% attendance requirement is not met.

Pass/Promotion Criteria will be implemented as per:

CBSE/AWES directions will be implemented as amended from time to time.

- 1. For classes IX/X to get promoted to the next class, a student has to secure 33% marks out of 80 marks in the theory paper of each subject in the Annual Examination. A candidate failing in two of the five subjects shall be placed in a compartment in those subjects, provided he/she qualifies in all the subjects in theory of internal assessments. The candidate will be promoted to the next class, subject to passing the supplementary examination which will be conducted only once.
- 2. For class XI/XII, a student has to secure at least 33% in Annual Examination as well as in overall weightage in each subject, to get promoted to the next class. In case of a subject involving practical work, a student must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% marks in practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in the subject. A candidate failing in one of the five subjects shall be placed in a compartment in that subject. The candidate will be promoted to the next class, subject to passing the supplementary examination which will be conducted only once.
- 3. For classes III-VIII, Evaluation will be carried out by combining the result of Term 1 (20% weightage for Periodic test 1 and Internal Assessment and 80% weightage Half Yearly Exams) and Term 2 (20% weightage for Periodic test 2 and Internal Assessment and 80% for Annual Examination).
- 4. For Classes I-II Grading System is applicable for promotion.

For Classes III –VIII

- 5. No Detention Policy is applicable for classes III to VIII. However, for students who perform badly, parents are advised to repeat the class for the betterment of the child or will be promoted with an undertaking from parents.
- 6. Annual answer scripts of finals will be shown to the students/parents only on submission of application to the Principal.
- 7. A pupil, who fails to appear in the annual examination even though he/she has secured sufficient marks in periodical tests and half-yearly examination, will be deemed to have failed in the annual examination and shall not be promoted



to the next higher class. However, if the absence from the annual examination was due to reasons beyond the control of the pupil, he/she will be given a supplementary examination on order of the Principal.

8. Report cards will be issued at the end of the session. If the report card is lost, replacement will be made only after the payment of Rs 100.

SCHOLAR BADGE

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SOP

Army Public School, Dhaula Kuan recognizes the academic achievements of its students in the form of several Academic Excellence Awards. These Academic Awards are given at the beginning of each academic year based on the performance of the student in the previous academic year.

A student is adjudged a STAR SCHOLAR BADGE from Class VI (the very first time on the basis of class V result) to class XII.

Note : In Primary Wing in class V, a child is given an academic excellence badge on the basis of class IV result but this is not counted in the STAR.

Eligibility Criteria for an award :

- i. Score 90% (i.e 89.5) and above in class IV and V.
- ii. Score 90% (i.e 89.5) and above in class VI to X.
- iii. Score 85% (i.e 84.5) and above in class XI in an academic year.

Sports Achievers (only State National & International Players)

They are eligible for a badge only after the verification of sports certificates by HOD of School Sports Department and if they score

- i. 85% (i.e. 84.5) and above in class IV and V in an academic year.
- ii. 85% (i.e. 84.5) and above in class VI to X in an academic year.
- iii. 80%(i.e.79.5) and above in class XI in an academic year

Note : Sports achievement should be of the current year in which the award has to be given.

For students with Special abilities

They are eligible for a badge only if the special educator verifies their medical certificates and if they score

- i. 85% (i.e. 84.5) and above in class IV &V in an academic year.
- ii. 85% (i.e.84.5) and above in class VI to X in an academic year.
- iii. 80% i.e. 79.5 and above in class XI in an academic year.

However, if a student is unable to appear for any major exam due to sports activity at state / zonal/ national level his/her retest marks would be considered for the academic award.
- The Badge is to be awarded only to Students of APS, Dhaula Kuan. However the previous record of new admissions coming in other schools would be considered for award if the child meets the criteria of having secured 90%(i.e. 89.5) in the current academic year's Half Yearly exams.
- For Class XI students (passed X Boards), Badge to be awarded to all students including new admissions as the evaluation is done by an external Board for all schools.
- 4. Academic excellence badge will be continued from the previous stars earned, if there is a gap of a year or more between the award receiving sessions.
- 5. No academic awards will be given for examinations that are conducted online. However, when students meet the criteria in the offline mode exams, all previous marks of online exams would be considered as per the eligibility criteria in order to ensure that there is no loss of number of stars and the student remains motivated.

PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEE

1. The fee is collected through Bank of Baroda Gateway, on a Quarterly basis as per

Schedule:-

1st Quarter-Payable by 10th April 2nd Quarter-Payable by 10th July 3rd Quarter-Payable by 10th October 4th Quarter-Payable by 10th January

- School fee to be paid only through Online mode. The instructions for the same are given at Sr. No. 9 of Student Diary (ALMANAC) under the heading ONLINE PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEE.
- 3. Parents are advised to keep the printouts of fee receipts in their safe custody and produce for reconciliation, if required.
- 4. In Case of change of Category of parents from OR to JCO/Officer, written intimation with photocopy of Part-II order should be given to the School Accounts Section at the earliest for updating Office records.
- 5. Fee structure is decided and revised by the School Management from time to time.
- 6. AWES (Red Book) Rules Article No.263:- Striking-off Name from the Rolls of the School

The following procedure shall be adopted for striking off the name of a student from the rolls of the school, for non-payment of school dues:-

- (i) If a defaulter fails to pay fees and fine within one month after the expiry of the due date, the Principal will send a written notice to the parent.
- (ii) If fees plus fine are not paid for two consecutive months, the name of the child will be struck off the school rolls.
- 7. As per Rule 35 and 167 of the DSEA&R, the school is allowed to strike off the name of the child for non-payment of school fee for 20 days after the due date of payment.
- 8. No fee will be accepted through NEFT/RTGS/TRANSFER. We accept only Online Fee (procedure given at Sr. No. 9 of Student Diary (ALMANAC) under the heading **ONLINE PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEE.**

- **Eleventh :-** After clicking online payment, go to PAY NOW (new screen will open as mode of payment (1. Bharat QR, 2. UPI, 3. Credit Card, 4. Debit Card, 5. Net Banking).
- **Twelfth :-** Make payment accordingly as per your convenience. You are not required to send the payment proof to the school, unless asked.
- **Thirteenth:-** If parent wants to pay the school fee for his two wards:- First, the parent will enter the details for online payment through DIGICAMPS Software for their 1st ward and after completion of payment, the parent will log out their 1st ward from the DIGICAMPS account, then the parent will enter the details of 2nd ward.
- 10. **Students of Class X to XI.** The results of Class X exams are published in May every year whereas the academic session starts in April. Provisional streams will be allocated to the children. They will only be allotted final streams post the declaration of the Board results. Every student will be on the rolls of the school till the date of issue of TC and will be required to pay 12 months' fees. Considering the above, the following procedure will be adopted for collection of fees from class XI students:-
- (i) As per AWES Rules (Red Book) (Rules and Regulations for Army Public Schools, Volume I (Administrative), Seventh Edition 25 Mar 2019 :-
- (a) Article No.209 Admission to Class XI at Page No.86 Sr. No.8 :- "Provisional admission



to Class XI on transfer certificate between April to June will be granted to the wards of Army personnel coming from other schools. Tentative stream will be allotted and the students permitted to continue till the declaration of result. On declaration of result, firm allotment of stream will be made as per laid down rules. Such students will pay fee of the tentative stream and the adjustment in fees will be made on final allotment of stream. This is also applicable to the students who pass Class X and seek admission in Class XI in the same school."

- (b) Article No.281 Note No.5. Collection of Fees. Page No.100 Sr. No.6 :- "When a student appears in the exam of Class X and the result is awaited, he/she shall be provisionally promoted to the next class and fee shall be payable as for other classes. In cases where the parent wants to withdraw the student from the school due to non-availability of stream of choice, *such decision if received either before or on 10th of the current month* will allow parent/student not to pay fee for the current month. If the same has been paid it will be refunded."
- (ii). As per Yellow Book (Rules and Regulations for Army Public Schools, Volume – II (Financial), Edition 2020, Chapter VII, INCOME, Fees : Collection and <u>Refunds</u>, 7.2 (e), Page No.39 the following fee procedure needs to be followed for the students of Class X going to Class XI :-
- (e) Students in Class XI. As regards a student's admission in Class XI, a Class X student will be deemed to be on the roll of the school till issue of Transfer Certificate after declaration of Board result. School also conducts classes for these students after allotting provisional streams. Every child has to pay 12 months' fees. Thus, taking all facts into consideration, the following procedure should be adopted:-
- (i) <u>Students Continuing in the Same School</u>. They will be required to pay tuition fee and annual charges from Apr onwards, to be paid in the month of Apr.
- (ii) <u>Students leaving the School</u>. If they apply for Transfer Certificate (TC) by 10th of a month, they will not be required to pay tuition fee and annual charges for that month. If they do not apply for Transfer Certificate by 10th of the month, they will pay tuition fee and annual charges for that month. The student who has attended class 10th exam and opted for the stream in Class XI as per his/her choice, will pay the fees applicable for that stream even if he/she takes TC from the school.

NEW ADMISSION

11. (a) Full fee is charged for the month of admission for a new student.

(b) The fee is to be paid from the following month of the last fee paid in the previous school.

- 12. AWES (Red Book) Rules Article No.282:- LATE FEE SCHEDULE If fee is not paid by the due date, late fee will be charged as under:
 - a) Upto 10th of the current month- NIL
 - b) Upto 20th of the current month- Rs.100/-
 - c) Upto 1 Month Rs.200/-



- d) Upto 2 Months Rs.400/-
- e) Upto 3 Months Rs.750/-
- **Note.** Non receipt of fee will be notified to the parent by email / post and a warning of 'Striking off from Rolls' will be issued after **(c) above.**

(for non-payment of school fee, see the 'DSEA&R 1973' Ruling at SI No.7).

<u>AWES (Red Book) Rules Article No.283:-</u> If fee and fine are not paid for more than three consecutive months, the name of the student will be struck off the rolls.

13. RE-ADMISSION / RE-TEST CASES

- (a) In case the re-admission of the student is approved, he/she will be charged readmission charges in addition to outstanding dues and fines.
- (b) All re-test cases are required to pay school fee on time as per school rules. No student will be allowed to appear for re-test unless or until he/she pays the school fee before appearing for re-test. Class X students attaining compartment in the CBSE Board shall pay fee up to September.
- (c) Student is required to pay fees in advance for the quarter (vide at SI No 1). In case a student seeks transfer certificate on any account before the 10th of a month, fee for that month and beyond shall be refunded. No Fee Clearance will be given unless the amount of fee is credited into the school account. Hence, the parents are requested to clear the dues and attach paid receipt & cancelled cheque of the parents alongwith TC clearance Form.

REFUNDS

- 14. When a student takes Transfer Certificate (TC) from school before or after completion of session, all the refunds due to him will be paid through NEFT only. Following instruction will be followed for refund of fee :-
- (a) **One Time Fee.** These are paid only once at the time of admission. All fresh entrants will pay these at the time of Admission, hence no refund.
- (b) <u>Tuition, Computer (TAL), Science, Sports and NIE Fee.</u> These are collected on quarterly basis. At the time of issue of Transfer Certificate, excess fee collected in advance will be refunded and the same will be endorsed in Transfer Certificate. Receiving schools will charge tuition fee for remaining months only.
- (c) <u>Annual and Development Charges.</u> These are paid at the beginning of the academic session (i.e. in April every year) and are refunded as per school rules, if TC is taken during the academic year.
- (d) <u>Security.</u> Security amount **Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only)** which is charged at the time of admission will be refunded through NEFT/Cheque after the completion of session or collection of Transfer certificate from School after submission of TC Clearance Form.
- 15. Fee Charging From Ex Servicemen / Navy / Air Force / Civilians paid out of Defence Estimates: -



- (a) Fee for the wards of Ex-Servicemen (Defence) Personnel would be the same as for wards of service personnel.
- (b) Navy & AF, Coast Guard, DSC, GREF and Civilians Paid out of Defence Estimates. At par with Army. This shall be suitably moderated to bring parity with the protocol of fee charged from wards of Army personnel by other services/organisations in their schools in the same station/location.
- (c) **CAPF**. As a general policy there will be No fee concession. Northern & Eastern Commands may extend the fee concession at their discretion. However, in stations where there are schools run by CAPF the concession will **NOT** be extended.
- (d) TA Personnel.
- (i) **Ex-Servicemen TA**. TA personnel retired with pension from TA to be treated as exservicemen and charged fee accordingly.
- (ii) **TA Personnel with Five Years Embodied Service**. The children of TA personnel with five years embodied service to be charged fee at par with the Army children.
- (iii) **TA Personnel with Less than Five Years Embodied Service**. The wards of TA Personnel with less than five years embodied service to be charged fee as applicable to civil children.

16. <u>CATEGORIES OF EX DEFENCE PERSONNEL TO BE EXTENDED PARITY IN FEE</u> <u>WITH SERVING PERSONNEL</u>

- (a) Ex-Army/Navy/Air Force/Coast Guard personnel granted / awarded regular pension, liberalized family pension, family pension or disability pension at the time of their superannuation, demise, discharge, release medical board /invalided medical board.
- (b) Recruits medical board out and granted disability pension.
- (c) Ex Army/Navy/Air Force/Coast Guard personnel who have taken discharge / release after 10 years of service,
- (d) TA personnel retired with pension or those who have taken discharge after 10 years of embodied service.
- (e) Members of MNS who have taken discharge after 10 years of service or are in receipt of pension from Army.
- (f) Ex-Army Postal Services (APS) personnel who have retired from APS after completing their minimum pensionable service and ex-APS personnel who had served in the Army on deputation for a period of 10 years.
- (g) Short Service Commission Officers who were released from service on completion of their terms of engagement.

17. TRANSFER CERTIFICATES

(a) It takes 7 days to prepare a Transfer Certificate. Duplicate TC is issued on deposit of Rs.100/- in Accounts office after submission of copy of FIR.



(b) A student who has once taken Transfer Certificate and seeks re-admission would be treated as a New Admission and would pay e-admission fees and security deposit at revised rates, if any. However, if the application for re-admission is submitted at an earlier date and the Transfer Certificate has not been issued to the child by the school then the admission will be granted on the old Admission Number.

INSURANCE POLICY FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF

An insurance scheme for all students and staff of our school has been made operative as per the direction/instruction of AWES

The period of the scheme is from 01 Aug to 31 July of the next academic year. Amount payable under the insurance policy on accidental death:

- (a) Employees/Staff 10 Lacs
- (b) Students 10 Lacs

Amount payable under the insurance policy to the insured on disablement as under, directly and solely due to an accident:-

- (a) permanent total disablement (100% disability) 10 Lacs
- (i) Loss of both eyes and/or both Limb 10 Lacs
- (ii) Loss of an eye and Limbs 10 Lacs
- (iii) Loss of an eye or a Limb 5 Lacs
- (b) Medical Expenses Upto 1,50,000/-

(for bodily injury arising out of an accident subject to treatment carried out in any hospital/nursing home or by Doctor (s) on submission of relevant prescriptions, bills, cash memo. X-Ray film along with reports, discharge summary etc in original)

5. Students are also covered for the Continuing Education Benefit in case of death/permanent total disablement of the paying parent / gauardian due to an accident including the border places. (War is excluded from the coverage). payable amount is disbursed on yearty basis by HQ AWES (through school) as per appendix-A' for balance period of school on receipt from the Insurance Company, If the affected student wishes to leave our school and join any other APS CEB benefit will continue (please get the same endorsed on TC before leaving our school) however, if the affected student leaves AWES institutions, then the balance amount of CEB will be paid directly to the claimant/ beneficiaries. for further education of the children up to class XII. In this case, the name of NOK / mother with mobile number and permanent address, unit / Regt of the father (for defence personnel) and bank account No. (cancelled cheque) be submitted to the school at the time of taking TC.



- 6. In the event of death or injury caused directly and solely due to an accident, Telephonic information to be given to the school within three hours. Written information will be submitted to the school by insured/NOK at the earliest• (preferably within 72 hours of the accident). Following documents are required to be submitted by the insured/NOK at the earliest (within 20 days of occurrence):
- (a) Claim form (available in the school) duly filled and signed by insured/NOK and Principal
- (b) Original copy of FIR issued by the Police Station.
- (c) Original copy of Postmortem Report or Post Mortem waiver certificate from the competent authority
- (d) Original Death certificate issued by the Municipality or authorities concerned.
- (e) Original fee receipts of the student with effect from the month in which the accident took place.
- (f) Discharge summary incase of hospitalization along with receipts/cash memos, prescription, X-Ray reports and other such details/supporting documents (original)
- (g) Original medical certificate (as per specimen) available in the school.
- (h) Electronic Clearance System (ECS) details of the insured person. along with cancelled cheque and front page of passbook.
- (i) Original/copy of Driving License (in case the death occurring while driving of a vehicle)
- (j) Copy of agreement between the employee and the employer (in case of death of an employee).
- (k) Copy of latest salary slip (in case of death of an employee)
- Electronic Clearance System (ECS) details of the claimant/beneficiary as per Appendix 'E' (held in the office) along with a Cancelled Cheque with Name of Account Holder be printed on cheque or Bank Pass Book front page with complete particulars of account holder.
- (m) KYC form duly filled along with photographs as per Appendix F (held in the office).
- (n) Pan Card and Aadhar Card duly signed by the Principal.
- (0) MoU between HQ AWES and Claimant for the CEB claim cases in respect of Students studying in Class I to Class XI as per Appendix G (held in the office).
- (p) Succession Certificate from the District Judge under Section 372 of Indian Succession Act Or Surviving Certificate/Legal heirs Certificate by Competent Authority for Death and Continuing Education Benefit claims.

STUDENTS USING PRIVATE SCHOOL CABS/TRANSPORT

- 1) Parents of children travelling by private cabs shall ensure that dropping time for private cabs is not earlier than 15 minutes before school time viz 7.10 am
- 2) Parents shall provide cab driver's verification to the school through the class teacher.
- 3) Parents shall ensure that there is a lady attendant/mother volunteer always present in the van.
- 4) The maximum number of children is limited as per norms based on type of vehicle.



TRANSPORT SAFETY GUIDELINES

Dear Parents

The school understands that the safety and security of students while in school or travelling to and from school is of prime concern for all of us. In this respect we need your co-operation. So let us make joint efforts to ensure their safety. Kindly go through the safety guidelines given below.

As you are aware of the fact that the school does not have buses of its own nor has it entered into contract with any individual or with any agency to transport students to school or from their respective homes. As such you should be vigilant to check the following documents etc. when you hire a private three wheeler/ auto-rickshaw/four wheeler/cab/van/bus or any other mode of transport. The following are based on the guidelines laid down by the Supreme Court, Rules & Regulations laid by the Delhi Government, C.B.S.E, and Child Protection Department.

- 1. Make yourself satisfied with the conduct and the antecedent of the owners, drivers, conductors and helpers of the vehicles hired by you. Also ensure that the "Police verification certificate" is obtained by them. (It is mandatory for vehicles carrying school children.)
- 2. Check the seating capacity of the vehicle hired by you and the number of children already enrolled with them, in order to avoid overcrowding. For buses/vans etc. One and a half number of the seating capacity.
- 3. Verify the validity of the fitness certificate of the vehicle, validity of the permit, Validity of the driver's licence and physical fitness certificate of the driver, experience of the driver in ferrying school children.
- 4. According to the directions laid by the Supreme Court, CBSE and Child Protection Department, the bus should have a speed governor, CCTV Camera, Door with reliable lock, Hydraulic jack, Manual, Emergency Exit (Right side and rear) Stop/sign arm, Retracting Step, School Bus insignia, Installation of flashing light /Buzzer working at boarding and de-boarding. Storage rack for school bags (as per policy), seat lay at exit (as per policy), Hazard warning apparatus, First aid kit, Firefighting kit, Horizontal grill fitted on windows, Lady attendant.
- 5. Advise your children

Do not allow your children to buy eatables from the street vendors as they are unhygienic. Do not drop your ward in school before 7.00 am in summer. Do not delay pick-up.
